Paddling the Waka Together, to Reach New Horizons

Thanks for all the work that you did as your child's teacher during the lockdown. We appreciate working together to keep providing educational opportunities for your child!

As you have had a large involvement in your child's learning over the past few months during the lockdown, our aim is to co-construct reports with whanau, based on what both whanau and teachers have noticed so far this year. There is a copy of the mid-year report over the page. Feel free to have a look at the report format and take some time to look at what we will be discussing together during the Learning Journey Conference. Please find below more information and explanations on Key Competencies, School Values and Other Curriculum Areas.

Key Competencies: The New Zealand Curriculum identifies Key Competencies that people use to live, learn, work and contribute as active members of their communities. Part of the "General" section on the report may include what has been noticed in relation to these Key Competencies. These include...

1. *Managing Self...*

This may include things such as setting goals, making plans, managing time or projects, being reliable with responsibilities, or setting and maintaining high standards.

2. *Relating to Others...*

This may include things such as the ability to listen actively, recognise different points of view, negotiate and share ideas, or how they are aware of how their words or actions impact on others.

3. *Participating and Contributing...*

This is about being actively involved in communities (such as whanau, school, or groups with a common goal) and may include things such as the ability to contribute appropriately as a group member, to connect with others, or have confidence to participate in next contexts.

School Values: Conifer Grove School has 5 school values. These are listed below with some examples.

1. *Respect...*

Being polite and courteous to others, show tolerance of others' differences, speak with kindness.

2. *Responsibility...*

Being punctual and prepared to start learning, look after our belongings, respect other people's property.

3. *Excellence...*

Always striving to do their best, set challenging goals.

4. *Honesty...*

Acts truthfully, presents facts honestly and with kindness.

5. *Caring...*

Kind and caring to others, include others where possible.

- Conceptual Curriculum (Science, Social Studies, Technology, Health)
