Kia ora whānau I hope you are safe and well.

We are delighted to be able to welcome more tamariki back onsite under Alert Level 3 this Wednesday 17 November. I can confirm that all onsite staff are fully vaccinated and have had a negative COVID test, great work by our team.

You will be hearing from your classroom teachers over the next few days to reconnect with our whānau's and community.

### What you can do to help:

- stay at home if you or your child is sick
- avoid catching up with other parents, children and whānau at the gates
- wear a face mask - No mask, no entry
- no parent entry into classrooms
- maintain a two-metre distance from people not in your household bubble

**School Uniform** - From Wednesday we ask that **all** students wear school uniforms, including our current bubble students. All students must wear a **sunsmart hat** preferably a school hat but we also understand if this is not possible.

**Drink Bottles** - All students will need to bring a drink bottle as the drinking fountains will be closed.

### Gate Entry

All students are to enter at the side gate in the **Evanda link (side pathway)** The gate will be unlocked from 8:40 am. Students will also use this gate to leave at 3 pm.

### Gate Exits organisation - Evanda link (side pathway)

**GROUP 1** - Ara Taupapa students will be at the gate at 2:50 pm and other Timata students will be there at 2:55pm. Kotahitanga classes will be dismissed at 3pm.

**GROUP 2** - Haemata students will be at the gate from 2:50 pm other Timata students will be there at 2:55pm. Whanake classes will be dismissed at 3pm.

### Mask wearing

Mask wearing is mandatory for all Year 5 -8 students. As the Haemata classes are composite Year 4 students are recommended to wear masks. All other students can wear masks if they wish.

## Parents onsite -

For Health and safety of all students and staff we ask parents to remain outside the school gates. If a parent wishes to be onsite they must arrange an appointment by emailing [admin@cgschool.ac.nz](mailto:admin@cgschool.ac.nz). Access will only be from Evanda pedestrian gate once the appointment has been made.
