



Great Times Out of School Care has been providing care to the school community since 2007, and is owned and operated by Trish and Paul Le Prou.

Trish and her staff pride themselves on creating an environment where the children attending are encouraged to participate and contribute. The Great Times team support positive behaviour and enjoy providing new experiences. Regular praise is given to the children letting them grow in self confidence while enhancing their self esteem.

Great Times Values

Children are cared for in a safe, healthy and stimulating environment where their needs are met and their learning is fostered. All children will be treated with dignity and respect.

Behaviour is managed with a firm but fair approach where clear boundaries and limits are in place. Great Times will work with parents/caregivers to rectify any unacceptable behaviour.

We aim to create a family centered caring approach where children feel Great Times is an extension of home.

DAILY PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

Before School Care

Great Times Before School Care Programme operates from 7.00am - 8.30am Monday to Friday with breakfast available from 7.00am - 8.00am.

Toast and cereal of the children's choice is available between 7.00am - 7.50am. Cereal only is provided between 7.50am - 8:00am.

The use of equipment and resources are available to the children during this time.

After School Care

Great Times After School Care programme operates from 2.50pm - 5.45pm Monday to Friday.

Our younger children are picked up from school while our older children make their way to us.

Attendance is recorded to ensure all children have arrived safely.

Time is given to unwind from school as children catch up with friends, relax and play.

Afternoon Tea

A nutritious afternoon tea of sandwiches, biscuits, water & juice is offered daily. Afternoon tea is varied at times with fruit, vegetables or baking made in cooking activities.

Homework

Children are placed in homework groups. Great Times' staff endeavour to aid children to complete their homework in the time available. However, it is the parents/caregivers responsibility to check that all homework is completed & up-to-date. Friday afternoons are homework free.

Children without homework are encouraged to read quietly, providing quiet time for those needing to complete set school homework.

Free Time/Set Activities

Children are offered the choice to participate in a planned activity or have self directed choosing time and may choose from our selection of toys, board games, drawing material, playstation, outside playground, sports equipment & team sports. (Playstation time is limited)

Wind Down Time

At the end of the day we finish with a fun game either active or quiet, sporty or thinking games, where the focus is on team sportsmanship and having fun, not winning and losing.

Daily Fee Structure

Before School Care - Breakfast Provided

\$ 9.00 for children booked am and pm
\$11.00 morning only
\$12.00 casual fee

After School Care - Afternoon Tea Provided

\$18.50 single child
\$17.50 per child for 2 children
\$16.50 per child for 3 children or more
\$19.00 per child for 1 permanent day only
\$22.00 casual fee
Rostered/Fortnightly care: \$5 per week
administration/holding fee applies to
receive the permanent rate.

Childcare subsidies are available to those who qualify. Please see the Supervisor/Manager for more information.

Payment of Fees

Fees are billed weekly.
Parents/caregivers are required to pay fees weekly in advance.
Fees payments can be made by cash, cheque or automatic payment. Eftpos is not available.

Lateness

All children must be collected before 5.45 pm.
Parents/caregivers must have a backup person to collect their child if they are unable to by 5.45 pm.
