We are excited to be taking our Year 7 & 8 students to camp next week. It has been almost been 3 years since we have been able to have our students attend an external camp. The students can't wait!! A big thank you to all our parent volunteers who have given up their time to support the Kotahitanga teachers, without your help we would not be able to have this camp proceed.

Changes to our School Uniform -We are phasing out grey boys shorts and tartan girls culottes and introducing unisex uniform items for all students. We believe that this will support whānau not only financially, but also keep our tamariki warmer in the winter months.


