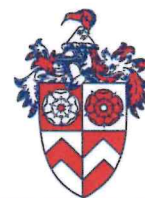

In-Zone Online Enrolments 2024



Enrolments for 2024 will be done online, this is a quick and easy way to enrol and can be done on your computer. If you don't have access to a computer, you will be able to use a computer in our reception or attend our open day on 29 July 2023 from 9.00am – 12.00pm and complete it in the Library.

Open Day - 29 July 2023

Follow these four easy steps to complete your enrolment:



Go to our website www.rosehillcollege.school.nz.



Check you live **IN ZONE** by selecting the Ministry of Education's **school zone** map on our home page. If your address is listed as an IN ZONE address proceed to the 2024 Enrolment button on our home page to fill in your application.

- Fill in all the information requested to enable the application to be processed.

The following documents **must** be attached to your application. We **will not** be able to process your application without these.

The following documents can be found on the online enrolment.

- EOTC consent form.
- Health form.
- In-zone enrolment questionnaire.
- Signed copy of the school-wide rules.

All of the following documents must be attached in PDF or JPEG format.

- Student's NZ birth certificate or passport - if neither of these apply then confirmation of NZ citizenship, or a passport with a valid student/resident visa is required.
- Any legal documentation regarding guardianship or custody rights.
- Electricity or water account
- Tenancy agreement or rates bill.
- Student's latest school report.
- Immunisation record (e.g measles vaccination - this can be obtained from your doctor)

Click on the 'Submit Enrolment Application'. If you need to come back to your application, click on "Remember Me". You will have 7 days to edit or add to your application.

Out-of-Zone Enrolments

In 2024, we may offer up to 30 out-of-zone places at Rosehill College. To apply, you must contact the college on 295 0695

Applications for out-of-zone students must be received no later than 30 August 2023. Please note that incomplete or late applications can not be included in the ballot which will be held on 6 September 2023.

Out-of-Zone Priorities

1. First priority must be given to any applicant who is accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the school.
2. Second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.
3. Third priority must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school.
4. Fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
5. Fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the Board or a child of a member of the Board of the school.
6. Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants.
