A warm welcome to new students and families joining our Conifer Grove School whanau this term as well as new staff members Dwain Samuels Room 8, Nicole Forbes, Room 11, Grant Lloyd Room 10 (Year 7&8), Neena Dhingra Room 1 (Year 1) and Subashni Prasad Room 23 (Year 4&5).

Ni Hao! this week we celebrate Chinese Language Week...the week began with a flag raising ceremony and display from our local Tai Chi group, with more activities happening throughout the week.

Pedestrian Crossings and safety - Adults please ensure you are modelling good road safety to our tamariki by using the allocated pedestrian crossings. We are very concerned by a number of near misses due to unsafe road crossing by students and adults near the dairy, roundabout and intersection over the bridge. On a daily basis we are seeing cars double parked, making dangerous turns, children running across the road to meet adults at their cars. PLEASE take care on our roads and have consideration for ALL of our students when dropping off and collecting your children - we have requested that the Auckland Transport wardens make extra visits to our area.

School Uniforms - thank you to families ensuring your children are in CORRECT uniform. We are seeing an increase in hoodies and odd items, bright coloured shoes being worn by students - these are not part of our uniform. Classrooms are heated in winter, students need to remove these non-uniform items when they arrive at school. If you are having difficulty with correct uniform items please inform a staff member and we will do our best to help find a suitable second hand item for you. Please name all items of clothing (including socks) with your child's name. If you are using a second-hand uniform make sure that all previous owners' names are covered up, to ensure that they are returned to you if misplaced. Black shoes, not boots, are the correct footwear for winter uniform Please NO nail polish, make-up, jewellery, temporary tattoos. Long hair must be tied back.

Attendance - We have had illnesses affecting staff and students over these winter months, and appreciate parents ensuring their children are well enough to return to school, however, I would like to reiterate the importance of attending school on a regular basis. Every day counts towards a child's learning and pays huge dividends for their future. Regular attendance is needed for children to continue learning and improving their basic reading, writing and other skills they need. It also means they are more likely to experience educational success. **Please remember that school starts promptly at 9am** with all students being at school no later than 8:45am to ensure they are settled by the bell time. Late students are a disruption to the rest of the class and it also means your child may miss out on key concepts at the start of the day. Have a great week everyone.
