Student behaviour

We continue to see a wave of disruptive behavior from a small group of students.

Please can you remind your tamariki /children that we place a big emphasis on our school values especially Whakamiha - Respect and Mana Motuhake - Responsibility. It is important that children know that there is a focus to learn at our Kura/School and that disruptive behaviors also affects the learning of others. We will be asking parents to support us with this in the coming term.

Attendance, lateness & early pickups

It is essential that your tamariki (children) are regularly attending school - this is the key to support the continuity that our Kaiako (teachers) seek, to be able to clearly focus on student achievement.

Non-attendance and lateness are closely monitoring and we would like to work with all whanau to ensure that students are attending regularly.

Tickets:
