Attendance, lateness & early pickups

Lockdown / Evacuation Exercise

Last Thursday 17 October, staff and students practised our emergency procedures under the guidance of Harrison Tew, who specialise in emergency management planning for schools and educational facilities. The procedures we follow allow us to respond safely and quickly to a range of situations. We are pleased to inform you that our practise went very well with our students responding safely and calmly. During the year we will continue to practise our emergency procedure exercises to ensure all staff and students remain familiar with them. Should you become aware of a lockdown or an evacuation at the school, can I please ask that you do not attend the school or phone, as we will not be able to respond. As your presence or contact may make it more difficult for us or the emergency services to manage a situation.
