2025 Teacher Only Days - please note these MOE approved dates on our calendar (page 2) during Terms 2,3,4.

Attendance - One of the things we are continuing to focus on in 2025 is student attendance. If a student misses one day of school every two weeks, they miss more than a whole year of school by 16 years of age. As a parent or caregiver, you, alongside our school, play a key role in building strong habits of regular school attendance.

All students are legally required to attend school every day and it is a shared responsibility to make sure students attend and engage in learning from when they first start school.

You must let the school know if your child is going to be absent or intends to be absent for a portion of the school term for whatever reason, like a tangi or medical procedure. Family holidays or taking time off for extracurricular activities (not organised by school) are not acceptable reasons for being absent. We expect reasons for absences to be reported to us by contacting the school office before 9:00 am by calling our Freephone: 0800 242255 (leave a message), by emailing: absences@cqschool.ac.nz or via the Skool Loop App or website absence notifications.

Knowing if your child is well enough to go to school can be tricky. Health guidance to support you to decide is available here. If you are still unsure, get in touch with us and let's work together to support your learner.

If you're struggling at home with getting your child to school, talk to us. If you are finding it hard to get your child to school, please talk with us so we can work together. Our school is committed to supporting your child to attend school.

Our school continues to build a culture that fosters attendance every day by having:

- ★ School staff who have strong relationships with students and family.
- ★ A school whānau that takes all practical steps to make sure your child is at school and progressing in their learning.
- ★ A school that is safe and welcoming for everyone in our school community.

Parking and Road Safety

Bikes & Scooters - Please ensure children are wearing a helmet and footwear when riding at all times, head injuries can be life changing.

Please remind children to dismount from their bike/scooter before they get to the school gate and walk to the bike racks. It is advisable to lock up your bike/scooter.

Evanda Cres has a NO STOPPING ZONE opposite the school office during pick up/drop times.

*PLEASE do not make dangerous turns at our school gates.

*PLEASE do not pull into driveways to drop off children.

*Having trouble finding a carpark? Try parking in one of the cul de sac streets and walk through the walkways into school, or parking further away and walking is a great option.

*PLEASE take care on our roads and have consideration for ALL of our students when dropping off and collecting children - this is a 40kmph zone and ensure you are modelling good road safety by using the allocated pedestrian crossings.
