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Literacy

We continue to teach literacy through a structured literacy approach, where students systematically learn to decode and encode sounds and words to support reading and writing.

Mathematics

We continue to build our number knowledge and explore how it applies across different curriculum areas and in everyday life. This term, our focus is on statistics, where students will gather and display data, and identify similarities and differences in category data.

Conceptual Curriculum

This term, our learning focuses on the big idea of Change. Through the context of health and relationships, students will explore how change can take different forms and affect themselves and others. They will also learn positive strategies to manage change.

Physical Education

This term, students will be developing their large ball skills such as throwing and catching through fun games like Hungerball, basketball, and soccer.
