# IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

#### Parking and Road Safety

Bikes & Scooters - Please ensure children are wearing a helmet and footwear when riding at all times, head injuries can be life chanaina

Please remind children to dismount from their bike/scooter before they get to the school gate and walk to the bike racks. It is advisable to lock up your bike/scooter.

Evanda Cres has a NO STOPPING ZONE opposite the school office during pick up/drop times. Traffic wardens randomly visit our school and may issue infringement notices for non compliance or unsafe driving.

\*PLEASE do not make dangerous turns at our school gates. \*PLEASE do not pull into driveways to drop off children. \*Having trouble finding a carpark? Try parking in one of the cul de sac streets and walk through the walkways into school, or parking further away and walking is a great option.

\*PLEASE take care on our roads and have consideration for ALL of our students when dropping off and collecting children - this is a 40kmph zone and ensure you are modelling good road safety by using the allocated pedestrian crossings.

School Uniforms (including hats and correct footwear) We expect all students to be in correct uniform, including hats: Hats are worn in Term 1 & 4 (Year 1-6 red bucket hat, Year 7-8 areen cap)

Footwear: Black shoes and socks or black sandals only please. Crocs, slides, jandals ARE NOT part of the school uniform. Uniform items can be purchased from the Warehouse, Takanini.
